



FIBRE INTERNET UPDATE

The 31st of December came and went... BT Openreach is struggling to deploy its fibre cables to the Kellaways exchange and is behind schedule.

If you are connected to the Kellaways exchange (phone numbers beginning 01249 740xxx) and in East Tytherton or Foxham, we were advised at the beginning of January that we would not have to wait much longer. So keep checking the DSL checker (dslchecker.bt.com). When an FTTC line appears in the DSL checker results, you will be able to order the service from an ISP as per the information in the January 2015 update. Remember, though, that there will be people on every cabinet who are in a slow-spot or a not-spot (either too far from the cabinet or with an exchange only line) so you may still find that you cannot order an FTTC service. If you do order, please let Scott/Jérôme know that you have done so and when you get connected we would like to know what speeds you get from http://www.speedtest.net/. This will help us support the request to extend high speed internet access availability in our villages.

For those living in Charlcutt and other areas with numbers beginning with 01249 740xxx not served by the 2 new FTTC cabinet, keep checking the DSL checker but you are probably outside the first wave. We would like to urge you to reply to the consultation (see below).

Residents of Bremhill and others who cannot get fast Internet access need to make their voices heard: Wiltshire Council has organised a public consultation (Superfast Wiltshire Public Consultation,

http://consult.wiltshire.gov.uk/portal/broadband/superfast_broadband_deployment

Unfortunately the closing date for submissions will have passed by the time this article reaches you. However, letters of support and late submissions will still be read and reviewed. So we would encourage you to write in to show your support/demand for better internet access in this area to influence the planning of the next deployment phase.

The aim of the fast Internet access deployment is to get people connected at superfast speeds (24 Mbps or better). The Phase 1 work is now nearly complete in the Bremhill Parish. There will be people who are connected to fibre and get less than 24 Mbps. These are the slow spots. There will also be a small number of locations where there is no fibre service. These are not-






spots. It is important to know where the clusters of slow-spots and not-spots are in the village. So if you are one of them and you want better broadband, you need to make yourself known to WCC and to Scott/Jérôme. The consultation is to find the areas to target in Phase2.

Finally, if you hear that your neighbours are connected to the fibre, and the DSL checker does not show FTTC is available, keep checking the DSL checker but you are probably still too far from your nearest cabinet to get a fibre connection from the Phase1 work. In that case, reply to the consultation and reply to us so we can begin to know where the not-spot people are.

Rather belatedly I wish you every blessing for 2015! Thank you also for the cards, good wishes and presents before Christmas – you are very kind.

It seems so long ago as we look forward towards Spring and Summer when new life begins to shoot and matures through the summer months. During the winter there has been rest and energy for the new season generated. But the season has been marred by the deaths in Pakistan and elsewhere, and now this week in France because of hatred based on religious difference and intolerance.
