On Wednesday a poor woman named Whittle, at Bremhill Wick, who was attending on a threshing machine, by some means got her arm entangled, and it was fearfully lacerated. She was removed to the infirmary of the Calne Union, and it was found necessary to amputate the limb. Under the care of Mr Bishop she is now doing well.
