I comend my precious and immortal soule into the hands of God my Maker and my fraile body to the earth whereof it was made and formed And as for my Goods and Chattells I give and bequeath as followeth Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Hayward and Jane Hayward my sonne and Daught All my Goods Chattells Implements Utensills of Householdstuff moneys and other things whatsoever of what nature or kind soever they be And alsoe I make and ordaine them my said Sonne and Daughter joynt Executors of this my Will And I doe hereby nominate and appoint Adam Tuck of Charlecott aforesaid Yeoman and Richard Scott of Siderow Clothier Executors in Trust of this my Will to and for the only

benefitt and behoofe of my said two Children and to pay and receive all Debts due and owing and to be accomptable to my said Children for the same when and as soone as they or either of them shall accomplish their full age of one and twenty yeares and I doe intreate and request the said Adam Tuck and Richard Scott Clothier my said Executors to take upon them the burthen hereof and to take care of my said two Children that they be well educated and provided for according as my estate Shall afford and what charges and expences my said Executors in Trust as aforesaid shall or may be att in reference to this my Will takeing upon the execution thereof my will is and I doe hereby give them and either of them power to reimburse themselves and be reimbursed out of my said Estate And for their care and paines in that behalfe I give them forty shillings apeice And I doe intreate and desire my loving ffriends Edward Jeferis of Siderow and Roger Cooke of Cadnam to be Overseers of this my Will and to be aiding and assisting unto my said Children and to my Executors in trust as aforesaid in their best councell and advice touching and concerning this my Will In Witnesse whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seale the Day and Yeare first above written The marke of Jane Heyward Signed sealed published and declared in the presence of us *Steven Davis William Slade* The marke of Maudlin Smoakham
