This is the last Will and Testament of me Priscilla Smallcomb of Tytherton in the Parish of Bremhill and County of Wilts Spinster I give to my Niece Ann Garrett of Norton Saint Philips my best bed bedstead and furniture and bedding thereto belonging the rest residue and remainder of all my real and personal estate due to me or in my actual possession I hereby give and bequeath unto my friend William Bryan Evenis of Tytherton aforesaid gentleman his heirs executors administrators and assigns In trust to equally divide the same between and amongst (after paying my debts and the cost of my funeral and the charges of proving this my will) my four nephews and nieces namely to James Waterman son of my late sister Joanna Waterman of Calne and to Alfred Garrett and Ann Garrett son and daughter of my sister the wife of Cornelius Garrett aforesaid and Harriet Smallcomb daughter of my sister Esther Smallcomb when they arrive at the ages

of 21 years respectively but in case either of them should die before arriving at the age of twenty one years the share of such my nephew or niece so dying is to be equally divided amongst the survivors share and share alike In witness I have signed my name and affixed my seal this twenty and fourth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three \_ *Priscilla Smallcomb*
