Ann: To the Schoolmafter Five Pounds p^r. Ann: For Ever. His Wife Elizabeth, Defcended from a reputable and worthy Family In Gloucefter-Shire. Survived him not long. She was a Daughter of M^r. EDMUND MORGAN Of Fairford Was Baptized June 23rd 1668; And dyed March 20th 1747. This Monument was erected as a Teftimony Of the Reverence and filial Piety Of their ever dutiful Son, JOHN WEEKS 1748.</p>
