In the Name of God Amen The Twenty fourth day of March in the Year of our Lord God 1724 I Ann Cripps of Brinkworth in the County of Wilts Spinster being at this time in good and perfect mind and Memory through the mercy of God but calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and resigning my Soul into the hands of God who gave it me do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following Imprimis I do give and bequeath unto my Loving Mother Ann Cripps the sum of Two Shillings & six pence Item I do give unto my Sister Mary Newell the sum of one shilling Item I do give unto my Sister Judith Cripps the sum of one shilling Item I do give unto my Couzen Edward Sarraude Son of Moses Sarraude of Dauntessey in the County aforesaid all that my Messuage or Tenement situated in the Parish of Wootton bassett which was formerly my fathers Edward Cripps son of Francis Cripps and after the Death of Edward Sarraude unto Moses Sarraude son of Moses Sarraude senr and after the Death of Moses Sarraude unto John Sarraude son of Moses Sarraude senr But my Will is that the said Edward Sarraude shall not Enjoy this Estate or Tenement till after the Death of my Mother Ann Cripps but if Edward Sarraude dye without male Heires the said Estate shall immediately fall to the sd Moses Sarraude and if the said Moses Sarraude dye without male Heires the said Estate shall immediately fall to the sa John Sarraude And of this my Last Will & Testament I do make & ordain my Couzen Edward Sarraude my full & whole Executor and I do revoke & Annull all former Wills & Testaments Ratifying & confirming this and none other to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal the day & year above written Arm Crípps
