Lance Corporal Frank Channing 320469 Royal Wiltshire Yeomanry - Son of Emanuel and Annie Channing of Dogdean Salisbury - born 1884 - Died 12th November 1917 at Passchendaele - commemorated on Panel 3 at Tyne Cot. Also on memorial at St Michael and All Saints Church, Sunnyside, Berkhamsted, Hertfordshire

Gunner Ernest Walter Ellery 14683 Royal Field Artillery 22nd Reserve Battery - Son of Walter and Emily Ann Ellery (Elkins) of Beaulieu, Downton Road, Salisbury - Born 1897 in Britford - Died 30th January 1915 at Royal Herbert Hospital, Woolwich - Buried in All Saints Churchyard, East Harnham

Lieutenant Thomas Algernon Fitzgerald Foley Norfolk Regiment 1st Battalion - Son of Frances Jane Foley (The Moat, Britford) and the Late Vice Admiral Francis John Foley - Born in London 29th December 1889 - Died 25thOctober 1914 fighting in Festubert -Commemorated on Panel 8 at Le Touret and also on Brampton Abbotts Memorial

Rifleman George James Godwin 1644 1/12th London Regiment - Son of George James Godwin Born 1896 in Salisbury - Died 8th May 1915 - Commemorated on Menin Gate Panel 54

Private Frank Judd 242190 1st Royal West Kent Regiment - Husband of Mary Jane Judd - Born in Lyndhurst. Enlisted in Salisbury - Killed in action in Flanders on 4th October 1917 - Commemorated on Tyne Cot Memorial Panel 106-108 - Also remembered on the Bramshaw and Nomansland War Memorials.





Leading Seaman Henry George Minchinton Z/4006 Royal Naval V. Reserves - Son of Mary Stratton (was Minchinton) of Knighton Road ,Broadchalk and the late James Minchinton - Born in Newbury, Berkshire on 4th April 1893 - Died on board the SS Ottokar 11th December 1917 - Commemorated on Portsmouth Naval (panel 28) and Tower Hill Memorial

Lance Corporal Gilbert Robins 200474 Wiltshire 1/4th T F Regiment - Son of George Henry and Annie Robins of Bentley, Downton Road, Salisbury - Born in 1890 in Salisbury died whilst a POW under the Palestine Administration on 10th April 1918 - Commemorated on the Jerusalem Memorial Panel 44





Private Edward Alfred Scovell 36448 2nd Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Son of Mr and Mrs Edward Scovell of Upend Lane, Britford - Born in 1899 in Gillingham - Died 20th October 1918 - Commemorated on Vis En Artois Memorial Panel 9

Private Herbert George West 10321 1st Wiltshire Regiment - Son of Walter Henry and Mary West of 37 Downton Road, Salisbury - Born 1889 in Britford - Died on 12th March 1915 - Commemorated on Menin Gate panel 53
