Tristram Huddleston Jervoise, Esq.

Wednesday morning died suddenly, in a fit of apoplexy Tristram Huddleston Jervoise, Esq. of Britford House, near this city, a gentleman of considerable property in this and the neighbouring counties. About two year since he bequeathed in Hampshire of £2500 a year, on his elder nephew George Purefoy Jervoise, esq. He has now bequeathed annuities to his other nephews: and to his brother Rev. Mr. Jervoise, the bulk of his fortune, supposed to be at least £8000 per annum.
