We understand that on the Coronation Day the inmates of the Alderbury Union Workhouse were regaled, by order of the Board of Guardians, with a plentiful supply of roast beef and plum pudding; added to which, each adult pauper was served with a pint of ale, and a like quantity of strong beer. The children were regaled in proportion to their age. The old people were also supplied with snuff and tobacco.
