To be sold by Mr Smith at Garraway's on Wednesday October 23, THE MANOR OF VERWOOD in the parish of Cranbourn, near Wimbourne, Dorset: near two extensive commons of about 1500 acres, with Verwood farm and lands, containing together 348 acres of arable, pasture and woodland; a farm house, barns and out buildings in the occupation of Mr Ambrose Witt and others.
