The Stone Coffin was taken up out of ye Church Porch.

It was discovered there about 20 years ago, when a Person of this parish was buried close by it. The Coffin then was opened \$\Delta\$ most of ye Bones in it were entire. Some of ye Stroud remain^d \$\Delta\$ a Cricifix made of Wood lay on ye Breast of ye Deceas^d \$\Delta\$ ye Head in ye Arch at ye Upper end of ye Coffin. When it was remov^d it was all mouldered to Dust except part of ye Skull \$\Delta\$ a very few of ye Bones. The othe Coffin had been taken up time immorial \$\Delta\$ had ye Arch for a Head.
