Sr John Theston was sometime Minister of this place: after him (as appears by ye former Register)

The Rev^d Mr Thomas Alcock was Vicar of this parish Anno 1629.
He was buried the 25 November 1664.

The Rev^d Mr Henry Dudley who was buried Feb^y ye 1st 1696/7.

He was succeeded by

The Rev^d Mr William Newlin who resigned this Living in 1704.

To

The Rev^d Mr Basil Davenport who was buried August 17th 1714.

He was succeeded by (being presented by Dr. Burnet)

The Rev^d Mr Thomas Frampton who was buried October 22nd 1753
After his death the Rev^d. Robt. Burnet Rector presented the Living to

The Rev^d Mr Algernon Clavering.

The Vicarage of Wilsford and The Vicarage of Broad Hinton is in the Gift of the Master of Saint Nicholas Hospital in Salisbury.

In the Year 1711 Bishop Burnet (As BP of Salisbury in whose Gift it is in) gave the Rev<sup>d</sup> Dr Thomas Burnett Rector of Westkington in this County & Prebendary of Sarum the Mastership of St. Nicholas Hospital.  
In ye Year 1735 he resigned the said Mastership (with ye BP of Sarum's leave) in favour of his only Son The Rev<sup>d</sup> Mr Robert Burnett Vicar of West Lavington & Vicar of Wilsford who died November the 25<sup>th</sup> 1769. Ætat. 62.



After his Decease Dr. John Hune BP of Sarum gave the Membership to his Nephew The Rev<sup>d</sup> Mr Nathaniel Hume, Rector of St. Laurence Jewry in London.
