GRAY/GREY, HENRY CHARLES - Private 12369 - 1st Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 14th July 1916 of wounds - Born in Tytherleigh, Heytesbury or Mitchelmarsh, Hampshire; Resident of Durrington or Milston; enlisted at Salisbury; Only son of John and Alice Mary Gray of Milston - Buried at Puchevillers British Cemetery, Somme, France - Grave/Memorial Reference:- I. F. 14. - Commemorated on the Bulford Village War Memorial.

HEDGES, CHARLES JAMES - Private 381137 - 2nd Battalion Hampshire Regiment - Died 5th September 1918 of wounds - Age 19 - Born in Bulford; Resident of Bulford; Enlisted at Salisbury; Son of William and Lucy Hedges of Bulford - Buried at Borre British Cemetery, Nord, France -Grave/Memorial Reference:- II. H. 38 - Commemorated on the Bulford Village War memorial.

MATTHEWS, THOMAS W. - Battery Sergeant Major 1770- 2nd/1st Warwick Batter, Royal Horse Artillery - Died 12th September 1917 - Age 38 - Born in Paignton, Devon; Enlisted in London; Husband of Ethel Jane Matthews of 21A Lines, Bulford Camp, Bulford Buried at Vlamertinghe New Military Cemetery, West-Vlaanderen, Belgium - Grave/Memorial Reference:- V. F. 12.
