FAMOUS ESTATE TO BE SOLD

The famous Savernake Estate, which includes the celebrated Manton gallops, is to be sold by auction in September at the Town Hall, Marlborough.

Formerly belonging to the Marquis of Ailesbury, the estate was bought at the beginning of the year by Mr. E. C. Fairweather for about £250,000 and then resold to Sir Arthur Wheeler.

In addition to the Manton gallops, it includes the villages of Collingbourne Ducis, Collingbourne Kingston, Easton Royal, Grafton, Mildenhall and Shalbourne, with parts of Great Bedwyn, Preshute, Burbage and Wilton.
