

Military Graves in Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne



ANDREWS, Edward - Private 18810 - 6th Battalion Wiltshire Regiment - Died 24th November 1916 - Buried at St. Sever Cemetery Extension, Rouen, France - Grave Reference O. II. L. 3. - Also commemorated on a family grave in Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne. Also named on the Calne War Memorial.





ANDREWS, Harry - Private 43449 - 4th Battalion Machine Gun Corps (Infantry) - Died 19th December 1918 - Buried at Valenciennes (St. Roch) Communal Cemetery, Nord, France - Grave Reference II. B. 5. - Also commemorated on a family grave in Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne. Also named on the Calne War Memorial.





ANDREWS, Jacob - Private 34503 - 14th Battalion Royal Warwickshire Regiment - Died 29th May 1918 - Age 20 - Son of Henry and Emily Andrews of Calne - Buried at Thiennes British Cemetery, Nord, France - Greave Reference Row A. Grave 14 - Also commemorated on a family grave in Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne. Also named on the Calne War Memorial.





PINNIGER, Arthur Frederick - Private 5570574 - 2nd Battalion Dorsetshire Regiment - Died 26th February 1945 of wounds - Age 24 - Son of Edwin Charles and Alice Pinniger of Calne - Buried at Taukyan War Cemetery, Myanmar - Grave Reference 19. G. 20 - Commemorated on his parents headstone at Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne. Also named on the Calne War Memorial.

RUMMING, Geoffrey Charlton Paine (C.G.M., M.M. (France)) - Chief Petty Officer F/8133 - Royal Naval Air Service attached to H.M.S. President II - Died 4th November 1917 - Age 29 - Son of William and Mary Nellie Rumming of Capenor, Portishead, Bristol - Wounded while attacking Turkish trenches in an armoured car at Gallipoli. He was awarded the Conspicuous Gallantry Medal and the Medaille Militaire. - Buried at Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne - Grave Reference A. 3. Also named on the Calne War Memorial.





SUTTON, Herbert John - Private 57552 - 76th Company, Machine Gun Corps (Infantry) - Died 6th May 1917 - Son of Joseph and Mary Sutton - Herbert has no known grave and commemorated on the Arras Memorial, Pas de Calais, France - His name is carved on a panel in Bay 10. He is also commemorated on a family grave in Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne. Also named on the Calne War Memorial.





WOODWARD, W. - Aircraftman 1st Class 61214 - 35th Squadron, Royal Air Force - Died 26th February 1919 - Buried at Curzon Street Cemetery, Calne - Grave Reference F. 36.
