

Post Office Directory Extract 1855 Calstone Wellington



Calstone Wellington, or Calstone Willington, a township and parish in the Hundred and Union of Calne, comprising a portion of the Borough of Calne, North Wilts., distant from Calne, 2½ miles south-east, and rear to an old Roman road. The church of St. Mary is very ancient, in the mixed early English and Tudor styles of architecture, in the patronage of the Marquis of Lansdowne, archdeaconry of Wilts., and diocese of Salisbury. The incumbent is the Rev. William Maurice Macdonald, D.C.L. The Marquis of Lansdowne is lord of the manor. Population, 36; acres 1,130

BLACKLAND is a parish in the same jurisdiction, with a population of 72, and 537 acres. Theobald's Green is half a mile north-west. On the downs are barrows.
