Mrs M L Archer

One of Fairford's most popular and respected citizens, Mrs M L Archer, had died at her home, Fairford House, at the age of 82.

The widow of the late Col David Archer of Castle Eaton, Wilts, Mrs Archer went to live at Fairford of the death of her husband in 1914.

In addition to being a member of the Parochial Church Council, and a churchwarden, she was the founder of the Mothers' Union in Fairford and was interested in the work of the Girls' Friendly Society, the British and Foreign Bible Society and the Indian Zenana Mission.

She is survived by a sister, Mrs Littledale of the same address and by a brother, the Ven. G S Hanbury of Dar es Salaam, Tanganyika.

A memorial service will be held at Fairford Church at 1.45 pm on Monday, followed by interment at Castle Eaton.
