

## Swindon & District Directory Extract 1928 Charlton



This picturesque village is 2½ miles from Malmesbury and 6 miles from Minety, and is in the Chippenham Division of Wilts, Union, County Court District and petty Sessional Division of Malmesbury, and Diocese of Bristol. The Church of St. John the Baptist, which stands inside the gates of Charlton Park, contains many memorials to members of the Suffolk Family. Its register dates from 1661, and it was restored in 1875 and in 1926. The living is a vicarage, with chapelry of Brokenborough annexed, joint net nearly value £384, including 40 acres of glebe, with residence. Adjoining the village is Charlton Park, the seat of the Earl of Suffolk and Berkshire, Lord of the Manor and sole landowner. Area, 4,766 acres; rateable value, £3,256; population in 1921, 423. Letters arrive through Malmesbury, and are despatched at 12.30 p.m. and 6.15 p.m. Money Order and Savings Bank business is transacted at the Post Office.
