



## *Pewsey Union*

### **TO BAKERS, GROCERS, BUTCHERS & OTHERS**

ALL Persons desirous of CONTRACTING with the Board of Guardians of this Union, for supplying the Workhouse at Pewsey, and one or more of the undermentioned Districts, with BREAD and FLOUR, from the 19th day of December instant, until and inclusive of the 20th day of March next, are required to deliver Sealed Tenders at the Board Room of the Pewsey Union Workhouse, by ten o'clock in the forenoon of MONDAY the 14th day of Dec. inst.

The Bread and Flour to be the best seconds, and to be delivered at the Workhouse, and at such other places in the Union, in such quantities, and at such times as the Board of Guardians, or the Relieving Officers may direct.

The Districts comprise the following parishes and places, viz.:-

- District No. 1. -- Pewsey Workhouse, and Pewsey Parish
- District No. 2. -- Milton, Easton, Wootton Rivers, Burbage, Collingbourn Kingstone, Collingbourn Ducis, and Everley
- District No. 3. -- Netheravon, Fittleton, Enford, Upavon, Rushall, Charlton, Wilsford, North Newnton, and Hilcott
- District No. 4. -- Manningford Bohune, Manningford Bruce, Manningford Abbots, Woodborough, Wilcot, Alton Priors, and Huish.

Any person may Contract for one or more District or Districts, but such contractor will be required to supply the whole district for which he may contract, and will not be allowed to under-let or dispose thereof, or any part thereof; and a; person who are desirous of Contracting with the said Guardians for supplying the said Workhouse with the undermentioned articles, or any of them, for the period above stated, are requested to deliver Sealed Tenders, marked "Provision Tender," at the said Board Room, by ten o'clock in the forenoon of the said 14th day of December instant.

Tea, sugar, treacle, pepper, candles, soap, (best yellow and mottled), salt butter, fresh butter, beef (without bone), mutton, and suet at per 1lb.  
Coal, half and half, and small per ton  
Cheese, salt, rice, and oatmeal per cwt.  
Potatoes per sack, 12 score  
Peas per bushel  
Vinegar per quart

And all other articles of Grocery not before mentioned, usually consumed in Workhouses, to be enumerated in the Tender, stating the price and quality of each article distinct.

The articles delivered at the Workhouse in such quantities, and at such times, as the Board of Guardians may direct.

Samples will be expected to be produced for the inspection of the Board.
