- 1. A messuage or dwelling house, with the garden, stable, outhouses and appurtenances containing in the whole about three quarters of an acre, situate at Chicklade aforesaid, and now rented by the Rev John Thaine Frowd, under a lease which will expire at Lady Day 1804.

6 The perpetual advowson or right of presentation to the church and rectory of Chicklade aforesaid, together with the glebe land thereunto belonging subject to the life of the present incumbent, aged about 45.
