Chicklade

Preferred. The Rev. Benjamin Blatch to the rectory of Chicklade in Wilts, on the presentation of Harry Edgell, esq.

(Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette - Thursday 5 October, 1780)

Thursday the 23rd ult, the Rev. John Still, L.L.B was instituted by the Right Rev. the Lord Bishop of Sarum, to the rectory of Chicklade in Wilts, on the presentation of Harry Edgell, esq, of Standerwick in this county.

(Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette - Thursday 9 March, 1786)

On Tuesday a Dispensation passed the Great Seal to enable the Rev. John Still, L.L.B, to hold the rectory of Chicklade, together with the Rectory of Fonthill Gifford, both in the county of Wilts.

(Oxford Journal - Saturday 22 July, 1797)

On Saturday May 25, the Rev. John Cooke Faber, M.A., was instituted by the Lord Bishop of this Diocese (on the presentation of the Marquess of Bath) to the Rectory of Chicklade, Wilts, void by the death of the Rev. John Still.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal - Monday 3 June, 1839)

The Lord Bishop of Salisbury has licensed the Rev. William Thomas Harte to Chicklade, Wilts.

The living of Chicklade near Hindon, Wilts, in the gift of Lord Bath and worth £230 per annum, has become vacant by the resignation of the incumbent the Rev. J. C. Faber, who has held it for thirty six years. (Hampshire Advertiser - Wednesday 27 October, 1875) The vicarage of Chicklade, in the gift of the Marquis of Bath, has been accepted by the Rev. G. W. Tayler, M.A., one of the masters of Marlborough College. (Western Gazette - Friday 31 December, 1875) The rectory of Chicklade, Wilts, in the gift of the Marquis of Bath, value £235 and a house, population 97, has become vacant by the death of the Rev. G. W. Tayler, formerly Assistant Master of Marlborough College, who was instituted in 1876. (Hampshire Advertiser - Saturday 31 July, 1886) The Marquis of Bath has presented the Rev. Estcourt Butler Merewether to the vicarage of Chicklade, Wilts, vacant by the death of the Rev. C. W. Tayler. (Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette - Thursday 30 September, 1886) Ecclesiastical Preferments.- Rev. J. F. Homan to Rectory of Chicklade, Wilts. (Bury and Norwich Post - Tuesday 18 December, 1888)

Preferments and Appointments Rev. J. F. Homan rector of Chicklade; also rector of Pertwood, Wilts (by dispensation) – patron, the Hon. P. Wyndham.
