HUNTING INTELLIGENCE

(A selection of newspaper notices over the years)

Mr Wyndham's Hounds – this day, the Beckford Arms, Fonthill; Wednesday, Chicklade Bottom; at half-past ten.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 17 February, 1840)

Mr Wyndham's Hounds – this day, Stockton Wood; Wednesday, Wardour Castle; Friday, Chicklade Bottom.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 20 December, 1841)

Mr Wyndham's Hounds – Monday, Chicklade Bottom; Friday, Rockbourne Racecourse - at eleven.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 22 January, 1848)

The South Wilts Hounds – Tuesday, Chicklade Bottom; Friday, Rockbourne Racecourse - at eleven.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 29 January, 1853)

The South Wilts Hounds – Monday, Chicklade Bottom; Wednesday (if rain), Deptford Inn; Friday (if rain), Fovant Hut - at eleven.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 11 March, 1854)

The South Wilts Hounds – Monday, Fovant Hut; Thursday, Chicklade Bottom; - at eleven.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal –31 March, 1855)

The South Wilts FoxHounds – Monday, the Beeches; Thursday (if rain), Chicklade Bottom; - at eleven.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal –15 March, 1856)

The South Wilts (Mr F. Wyndham's) Hounds – Monday, Whitsbury; Friday, Chicklade Bottom.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal –23 January, 1858)

The South Wilts Hounds – Monday, West Park; Friday, New Inn, Chicklade Bottom – at eleven.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal –15 January, 1859)

The South Wilts Hounds – Monday, Chicklade Bottom; Wednesday, Alderholt Mill; Friday, Fovant Elm,– at 10.45.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 21 January, 1860)

The South Wilts Hounds – Monday, Ferne; Wednesday, Bowlesbury Farm; Friday, Chicklade House – at 10.45.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – 23 February, 1861)

The South Wilts Hounds – Monday, Chicklade Bottom; Wednesday, Bowlesboro' Farm; Friday, Berwick St. John– at 10.45.
