The new "Oyland" motor fire engine, which has just been purchased, was christened on Saturday afternoon, the ceremony being preceded by a luncheon at the Angel Hotel, presided over by Mr. Charles Garnett, (chairman of the committee.) The Mayor formerly accepted the motor engine on behalf of the town, and the christening afterwards took place in the Market Square, in the presence of a large crowd, by Miss Garnett. The engine cost £1,600, which has been raised by subscriptions.
