WHITTAKER, WALTER JOHN - Marine PO/X 367 - Royal Marines - H.M.S. Royal Oak - died 14th October 1939 - age 34 - son of Frederick William and Florence Whittaker of Woodlands, Chippenham; Walter was resident of 3 Downing Street, Chippenham - Commemorated on the Portsmouth Naval Memorial, The Esplanade, Southsea, Portsmouth, Hampshire - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 36. Column 2 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham

**WHITTLE, DENNIS JOHN -** Fusilier 14610138 - 2nd/5th Battalion Lancashire Fusiliers - died 29th July 1944 - son of George H. and Gladys M. Whittle of Chippenham - Buried at Fontenay-Le-Penel War Cemetery, Tessel, Calvados, France - Grave/Memorial Reference - II. D. 13.

WOOD, THOMAS REGINALD - Steward D/LX23014 - Royal Navy - Died 19th December 1941 aboard H.M.S. Neptune; vessel lost after hitting mines 20 miles off the coast of Tripoli) - son of William Albert and Florence Wood of Chippenham; Commemorated on The Plymouth Naval Memorial, The Hoe, Plymouth, Devon - Grave/Memorial Reference - Panel 56, Column 1 - Commemorated on the Chippenham Town War Memorial, Market Place, Chippenham
