Died on Oct 29, the Rev. Thomas Bullock, Rector of Castle Eaton, and Vicar of Chiseldon, in the county of Wilts, aged 46. **Berkshire Chronicle Saturday 7 November 1846**

We are sorry to have to announce the melancholy death of the Rev. Thomas Bullock, rector of Castle Eaton, and vicar of Chiseldon. It appears that about 10 o'clock on Thursday night last, as he was driving near the Swindon station, the horse suddenly jumped round, by which Mr. Bullock and his servant were both thrown out, and the former gentleman was killed on the spot. The servant escaped with some slight bruises. The Rev. gentleman was about 46 years of age and has left a widow and seven children.
