



Bankruptcy of William Windsor

To CREDITORS.

WHEREAS, WILLIAM WINDSOR, of Chittern All Saints, in the county of Wilts, yeoman, hath, by deed dated the 23rd day of June, 1780, assigned and conveyed all his estate and effects to trustees, for the benefit of his creditors, in such manner as particularly expressed in the said deed, who are to accede to the terms of, and execute the same, within two months from the date thereof, or be excluded all advantage to be derived therefrom: And the creditors of the said William Windsor may peruse such deed, by applying to Mr. John Thring, of Codford St. Peter, Wilts, in whose hands the same is lodged, and to whom they are requested immediately to bring or send an account of their several demands.
