On Saturday Coroner F. T. Sylvester held an inquest at the White Hart Inn touching the death of William Tilley, seventy-four years of age, who has been living with his married son at Chitterne for some time past, and who was found dead in bed on Saturday morning. Evidence was given to the effect that Dr. Ward attended deceased in June last for heart affection, and the jury returned a verdict of "Death from heart disease."
