Sudden death of a child An inquest was held on Wednesday inst, before Mr. R. M. Wilson, coroner, on the body of Emma Baker, an infant aged one year and ten months, who had died suddenly, at Chute. It appeared that the deceased had been a very sickly child from its birth, and the medical man who attended it was of opinion that its death was caused by effusion on the brain. Verdict accordingly.
