The Poor Rate document measures 20" x 7½ inches, sewn together at the left side to form a long roll. This book includes the year 1891.

## HEADING TO THE RATE

An Assessment for the Relief of the Poor of the Parish of **Clyffe Pypard** in the County of **Wiltshire**, and for other purposes chargeable thereon, according to law, made the **10<sup>th</sup>** day of **May**, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and **ninety**, after the rate of **one shilling & sixpence** on the pound, which is estimated to meet all expenses for the above purposes which will be incurred before the **29<sup>th</sup>** of **September** next, and which Rate we declare to be payable by **Two** equal instalments (or by the following instalments, that is to say, \_\_\_\_\_ shillings **Nine** pence in the Pound and \_\_\_\_\_ shillings at **Nine** pence in the Pound) to be paid respectively at the following dates, that is to say, on the **2<sup>nd</sup>** day of **June** and on the **11<sup>th</sup>** day of **August next**.

In this part, only the relevant columns 1 to 11 have been transcribed. The remaining columns 12 to 18 which covers the first and second collection of monies, has been ignored.
