ASHTON GIFFORD INCLOSURE

The Commissioners named and appointed in and by an Act of Parliament passed in the present session, for enclosing Lands in the Tything of Ashton Gifford, in the parish of Codford Saint Peter, in the county of Wilts, hereby give Notice, that they intend to hold their first meeting, for carrying into execution the powers vested in them by the said Act, at the house of Richard Frances, called the George Inn, in Codford Saint Peter aforesaid, on Wednesday the twenty-ninth day of June next, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, at which time and place a banker, or such person or persons as shall be approved by a majority in value of the proprietors who may be present, will be appointed to receive monies raised for the purposes of the said Act, pursuant to the directions of an Act of Parliament, commonly called the General Inclosure Act. – Dated May 30, 1814.
