Death of Mrs Margaret Walker

A wide circle of friends and a great many returned soldiers will regret to learn of the death of Mrs Margaret Walker, wife of Mr Ernest Walker, of 51 Mont Albert Road, Canterbury, which occurred on Tuesday. Mrs Walker did a great deal of honorary work in the war. She was in charge of the general canteen at Woolwich Arsenal, which was, during her service, repeatedly bombed by German aircraft. The severe nervous strain eventually necessitated her leaving the area, and she then served in A.I.F. canteens at Codford and Parkhouse camps.
