

## SOUTH WILTSHIRE CORONER'S INQUESTS Codford



Newspaper Reports

Henry Colston Watkins 17<sup>th</sup> May, 1843

On Wednesday the 17<sup>th</sup> inst., at the George Inn, at Codford Saint Peter, on the body of Henry Colston Watkins, a child of two and a half years old, who died there suddenly on the preceding day, during the stoppage of Simon's van, by which he was a passenger, his mother being on her road with him into Gloucestershire. The child had recently had the measles, and no doubt died from exhaustion arising from inflammation of the lungs, consequent upon that complaint.

Verdict accordingly.
