



Coroner's Inquest Report

Sarah Trowbridge 1843

12th September, 1843

An inquest was held by Mr Wilson, on Tuesday last, at Codford St. Peter, on the body of Sarah Trowbridge, a girl of six years old, who died on the previous day, after a very short illness, accompanied by violent purging and sickness. From a post-mortem examination of the body she was found to have been laboring under dropsy of the pericardium. Verdict accordingly.
