Newspaper Reports

William Sparey 4th March, 1835

Mr Whitmarsh held an inquest on Wednesday last, at Codford St. Peter, on the body of William Sparey. Deceased was employed on the previous Saturday in thatching a barn, and, whilst he was on the roof, he by some means fell to the ground. He was taken up, much injured in the spine, and died on the following Monday.

Verdict, "Accidental death."
