Frederick Carpenter

Frederick Carpenter was born on 28th August, 1891, at Codford, to parents Thomas & Julia Carpenter (nee Romain). His birth was registered in December quarter of 1891 in the district of Warminster, Wiltshire.

Frederick was recorded as a 9 year old in the 1901 England Census living with his family at Main Road, Codford St. Peter. His parents were recorded as Thomas Carpenter (Police Constable, aged 39, born Deverill, Wiltshire) & Julia Carpenter (aged 40, born Devizes). Six children were recorded – George Henry (Grocers Errand Boy, aged 12, born Chilton Foliat, Wiltshire), Colbourne (aged 11, born Corsley, Wiltshire), then Frederick, Ethel (aged 7, born Codford), Alfred Thomas (aged 5, born Codford) & Kate (aged 3, born Codford).

The 1911 England Census recorded Frederick as a 19 year old Labourer living with his family in a 5 roomed dwelling at 24 Mill Lane Cottages, Box, Wiltshire. Frederick's parents were recorded as Thomas Carpenter (Policeman, aged 48) & Julia Carpenter (aged 50). Frederick's parents had been married for 25

years, having had 7 children, with one child deceased. Frederick was recorded as the oldest living at home, also included were Ethel (aged 17, Nurse - Domestic), Alfred Thomas (aged 15, Grocer's Apprentice) & Kate (aged 13).

A marriage was registered in the September quarter of 1918 in the district of Swindon, Wiltshire between Frederick Carpenter & Ethel/Ellen Reeves.

Frederick Carpenter & his wife Ethel sailed from London on S.S. *President Adams* on 3rd March, 1923 bound for New York. Frederick was recorded as 31 year old House Painter & his wife Ethel was recorded as a 27 year old. Their last residence was recorded as Swindon & their final destination was recorded as Madison, New Jersey. The name of nearest relative for both Frederick & Ethel was listed as Mr T. C. Carpenter of 49 Ipswich St, Swindon.

The 1930 United States Federal Census recorded Fred Carpenter as a 36 year old House Painter living with his wife Ethel (aged 33) & 2 sons – Kenneth (aged 10, born England) & Eugene (aged 3, born New Jersey). Fred was recorded as being 25 years old when he married & Ethel 22 years old. The family were living at 11 Greenwood Ave, Madison, New Jersey.

On 26th July, 1941 Frederick Carpenter was crossing from Canada to United States at Niagara Falls as he had received permanent residence.
