## **THREE GUINEAS REWARD**

Whoever, therefore, will give such information to the Parish Officers of Codford, so that the said John Penny shall be apprehended, and afterwards examined touching his legal place of settlement, shall receive the above reward.

The said John Penny is about 38 years of age, 5 feet 9 inches high, rather stout, with light hair, pale complexion, and a full face, and his right thumb is injured with a gun. He was dressed, when he left Codford, in a green coat, buff waistcoat, and light small-clothes, and was in the employ of Mr James Raxworthy.
