NOTICE is hereby given, that the Churchwardens and Overseers of this parish are in possession of the following articles, supposed to have been stolen by persons lately committed for trial for other offences, namely, one Black Silk Cloak, ten yards of cross-barred Cambric Muslin, sixteen yards of different Linens, several Shawls, ten different Handkerchiefs, several pair of Men and Women's Hose, three Gowns, two pair of Velvet Shoes, a Man's Hat, two Petticoats, one yard of Muslinet, one Apron made of Cheese-cloth, one Sack marked "W. Savage, G. Elm," another Sack marked "H. Crine, Winterslow;" and it is desired that any person or persons having lost any of the like articles, will immediately apply to the Churchwardens and Overseers of this parish, in order to identify the same, and to adopt such measures as may bring the offender or offenders to justice.- *June 26, 1807.*
