



Codford St. Peter's Church

Salisbury and Diocesan Church Building Association

The quarterly meeting of the general committee of this association was held on Thursday last, at the Board-room in the Close. The Right Rev. the Lord Bishop of the Diocese in the chair.

The remaining case was that of Codford Saint Peter. It was an application from the rector (Rev. H. Wightwick) and churchwardens of the parish, for aid towards building a new North aisle to the Church and increasing the accommodation. At present, for a population of 359 persons, there is only seat room for 166, including 20 free sittings. By the contemplated alterations a gain of 47 sittings will be secured, making the total 223, *i.e.*, 146 appropriated and 77 free sittings. Of the estimated expenditure (£1260) about £800 has been provided, and the committee therefore voted a grant of £60.
