The Will and Codicil, dated April 13 and May 12, 1877, of Mr John Ravenhill, formerly of Ashton Gifford, Wilts, but late of 2, Waterloo-place, Weymouth, who died on the 2nd ult., were proved on the 2nd inst. by Colonel Philip Ravenhill, the Rev. Henry Everett Ravenhill, Lt.-Col. Frederick George Ravenhill, and Mr William Waldron Ravenhill, the sons, the acting executors, the personal estate being sworn under £45,000. Subject to a bequest to a faithful servant, the provisions of the Will are wholly in favour of his children.
