



Inquest Report on John Kaisey

Inquests before Mr. Coroner Sylvester:

At Collingbourne Kingston, on John Kaisey, aged 70 years. The deceased had visited the inn at the above place, and was reported to have been exhilarated, but not tipsy; on coming out of the house, some person accidentally ran against him, causing him to fall heavily on the back part of his head, producing concussion of the brain and extravasation of blood, from which he died three weeks after.

Verdict, "Accidental Death."
