



Inquest Report on Thomas Cole

Inquests taken before Mr. Coroner Sylvester:

At Collingbourne Kingston, on Thomas Cole, aged 70 years. The deceased was an agricultural labourer, and had been to his employment; on his return homewards, he fell to the road and expired instantly, from valvular disease of the heart.

Verdict – “Visitation of God.”
