



Police Court

There were only minor offences dealt with at Calne Police Court on Monday. Alec H. Hamilton Hill, of London and Frederick Turner, of Chesterfield, were both fined £1 for speeding offences and the latter had his licence endorsed. A fine of 5s. was imposed upon Frederick C. Smith, of Whites Farm, Compton Bassett, for driving a motor car without dimmed headlights and without dimmed traffic indicators. Henry Arthur Brittain, of Bristol, had to pay 5s. for not conforming to a halt sign. For lighting offences with bicycles, Percy Davis, of 31 Greens Lane, Cherhill, was fined 7s.6d., Beatrice Pearce, of Little Avebury, 10s. and Cecil Harrison, of Boilings Lane, Calne, 10s. Maureen O'Conner, of 25 Bryan's Close Road, Calne, was fined 10s. for causing a light to be visible at that address and Albert Ronald Weakly was fined 5s. for permitting it.
