In the name of God Amen The Twelfth day of May One Thousand six hundred and Twentie I William Vivash the Elder of the Parish of Compton Bassett I the Countie of Wiltes Yeoman being sicke in bodie but in good remembrance thankes be to God doe make this my last will and testament in manner and forme as followeth. First I bequeathe my soule into the handes of God holpinge to be saved by Christs merritts and my bodie to be buryed in the Church of Compton aforesaid. And my worldly goodes as followeth. Item I give to my Parish Church tenn shillings. Also I give and bequeath to Marye my oldest Daughter one hundred pounds of good Engles money to be paid within three monthes after my decese. Also I give to William and Wiliam my Sonnes and Jane my Daughter to eche of them one sheepe. Also all the rest of my goodes and chattells moveable and unmoveable that is not given nor bequested I give and bequeath to Agnes my Wife whom I make my whole executor to perform this my last will and testament. Also I do nominate and appointe Richard Burchall and Walter Burchall to be my trewe overseers
