## *Compton Chamberlayne*

The CLERK of the PEACE read a report respecting the liability of the county for the repair of a culvert near the Horseshoe Bridge, in the parish of Compton Chamberlayne, in which he expressed an opinion that no other parties could be called on to pay the expenses. An order was made in accordance with this opinion.

Mr FOWLE stated that a new bridge was about to be erected at Winterbourne Gunner, which, when completed, the county would be asked to adopt.

Notice of a motion was also given for the next sessions for the widening of a bridge at Compton Chamberlayne.
