William Targett 12th May, 1853

Found dead in Bedroom

An inquest was held by Mr Wilson on Wednesday last, at Berwick St. James, on the body of Jonathan Gilbert, who died very suddenly on the previous morning whilst at work in the fields.

Another inquest was also held by the same Coroner on Thursday, at Compton Chamberlaine, on the body of Mr William Targett, who was found dead in his bed-room on Thursday morning last, without having had any previous illness, and verdicts of "Died by the Visitation of God" were returned in both cases.
