MARRIAGES

Last Monday was married Mr Scammel, of Compton Chamberlain, a healthy old oak of 66, to Miss Mary Foyle, of Wiley, a blooming belle of 21.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 21 January, 1788)

On Tuesday last was married, at Compton Chamberlain, in this county, by the Rev. Penruddocke Wyndham, Mr Wm. Kemp, of Romsey, carrier, to Miss Sophia Moore Pigott, youngest daughter of the late Capt. Pigott, of Compton Chamberlain.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 10 November, 1817)

On Friday last was married, at Compton Chamberlayne, in this county, by the Rev. T. H. South, A.M. Edmund King, Esq. of North Stoneham, in the county of Hants, to Maria Constanca Piggott, 3d daughter of the late Capt. Pigott, at Compton aforesaid.

On the 29th inst., at St. George's, Bloomsbury, by the Rev. Frederick Gutteres, vicar of Compton Chamberlayne, Wilts, James Gutteres, esq., of the Middle Temple, to Susan Julia Hogarth, eldest daughter of the late Captain John Barton Goch, Hon. East India Company's Service, of Camberwell.

Married, at Pimperne, on Wednesday last, by the Rev. Wm. Ewart, John, the youngest son of the late Mr Rowden, of Compton Chamberlain, Wilts, to Elizabeth, only daughter of Mr Alexander, of the Manor Farm, Pimperne.

DEATHS

On Thursday last died, after a long and painful illness, greatly lamented by his family and numerous friends, Mr John King, of Compton Chamberlain, in this county, aged 80 years. He was a most worthy and honest man, and a friend to the distressed.

Died, on Wednesday, the 16th inst., Mr Turner, of Compton Chamberlaine, aged 81 years.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 28 June, 1830)

Died, on Thursday last, at Stourton, Miss King, daughter of the late Mr King, of Compton Chamberlain.

(Salisbury and Winchester Journal – Monday 4 April, 1831)

Died, on the 8th inst., after a severe and protracted illness, deservedly respected by all who knew her, Mrs Rowden, widow of the late Mr Rowden, of Compton Chamberlain, aged 54.- Her family has to deplore in her loss a kind and tender parent, and the poor a liberal and generous benefactress.

On Thursday last, at Search Farm, Stourton, and late of Compton Chamberlayne, Somerset, Mr Henry King, in the 61st year of his age.

Died, on the 24th inst., at her sister's, the Miss Smiths', Compton Chamberlayne, Mrs Beckett, wife of Mr Beckett, late of Road, Northamptonshire.
