Sir W. M. Whyte Believed Killed

A man believed to be Paymaster Rear-Admiral Sir William Whyte, but not yet definitely identified, was killed in a car accident near Wilton, Wilts, yesterday. The man was the only occupant of the car, which came into collision with a telegraph pole between Barford St. Martin and Compton Chamberlayne on the main road to Salisbury. A driving licence found in the man's possession bore the name Sir William Marcus Charles Beresford Whyte, and gave the address as the Army and Navy Club, London. There it was stated last night that Sir William's name did not appear in a current list of members.
