



## *Coombe Bissett* *1800-1849*

### **1805**

The 1st inst., at Coombe, near Salisbury, in the 73d year of her age, Mrs. Martha Leach Street, late of Dinton, in the county of Wilts. She had a great grandfather who lived to the age of 104, a grandfather on her side to 109, a great grandfather on her husband's side to 106, and a grandfather to 98; all of whom were living with her and her husband's father, on the day of her marriage. She died possessed of a considerable estate, with part of the original building a curious structure, which had been held by her family for many centuries. **Hull Packet, 10 December 1805**

### **1812**

On Wednesday last died Mr. William Baker, blacksmith, of Coombe Bisset, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 15 June 1812**

### **1825**

On Monday last died, aged 66 years, Mrs. Jane Flower, wife of Mr. John Flower, of Coombe Bissett. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 7 February 1825**

### **1834**

Married, on Wednesday last, at Coombe Bassett, by the Rev. Mr. Shrabb, Mr. John Harris, boot and shoe maker, of Coombe, to Miss Ann Poole, of Alvediston, both in this county. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 27 October 1834**

### **1835**

Died, on Saturday, the 3rd inst., much respected and esteemed, Mary Anne, the beloved wife of Mr. Charles Harwood, of Bath Place, Kensington, and of Coombe Bissett, near this city. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 12 October 1835**
