Dreadful Accident at Corsham - Three men Killed!

A frightful accident occurred at Corsham this (Thursday) morning, by which three men have been momentarily deprived of life. It appears that they were at work, with several others, in the extensive stone quarries of Messrs. Randell and Saunders, when a large bed of stone gave way, and killed them upon the spot. Their names are Vowles, Mizen, and Hulbert: each of whom has left a wife and family. The other men in the quarry escaped unhurt.
