In the name of god Amen December thirty one Anno Domini one thousand fyve hundred and Nynty I William Kington of the parishe of Corsham in the countie of Wiltes yeoman sicke in body but of perfect memorie God be thanked for yt Do make my last will and Testamente in manner and forme following ffirst I commend my sowle to Almighty God reposinge my hope in the assurance of my Salvation onely in the Death and passion of our Saviour Jesu Christ And my body I commend to the earth Item I give to the poore of Corsham tenne shillings Item I give to my fowre Daughters fourty pounds a peece to be paied unto them at the daye of theire marryage And yf anie of my Said Daughters happen to Die before the said Daye Then my will is that her portion shalbe equally Devided amongest her sisters survivinge Item I give to my sonne William two leases of certayne ground which I houlde at Atford Duringe the yeares yet to come The one lease of John Woodman the other of Thomas Pinchin Item I give to Henry Rudman one calf And I will that the same shalbe kept for him untill it be a yeare onlie Item I bequeath to my wife Susan all my lands at Atford for the Terme of fyve yeares towardes the payment of my Children's Legacies And I will that afterward the same shall remayne to my sonne towards his maytenance All the residue of my goods bequeathed my body honestly buried and my Debtes paied I give and bequeath to Suzan my wife whome I make my whole and sole Executrix And I appoint my welbeloved in Christ Mr John Beawsian and my brother Lawrence Kingston my Overseers to see this my Testamente performed accordinge to my mynde And to each of them for theire paines I give Twelve pence Witnesses to this my last will John Gibbins John Pinchin John West Edw: Atkins Hugh Reade with manie others
